A SPIRITUAL FEAST

According to the record in II Chronicles 35:18 & 19, the Passover kept in the eighteenth year of Josiah's reign was very special. Likewise, the Marriage Seminar and gospel meeting with Brother Bill Davis (officially, Dr. Bill Davis), was exceptional! From my vantage point, the congregation here in Killeen has experienced a great spiritual feast because of his efforts! We heartily thank all who were in attendance because they wanted to improve their marriage! This is the kind of attitude that all Christians should have about their service to God! ALL OF THE MEMBERS OF THIS CONGREGATION NEED TO "KEEP ON MAKING SPIRITUAL IMPROVEMENT THROUGHOUT OUR LIFE!!"

The emphasis of Brother Davis in the gospel meeting was from Psalm 23, and was designed to help all of the ones who heard the messages to know more of the sheep's responsibility to "THE GREAT SHEPHERD OF THE SHEEP," Hebrews 13:20, and to understand the great love, care and concern He has for His sheep! Ultimately, God's sheep will dwell in the house of the Lord forever-Psalm 23:6; John 14:1-3. One of the great mysteries of this Great Shepherd is that He also was the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world-Revelation 13:8.

Our meeting climaxed with Gianni Griffith confessing Jesus Christ as Lord and being baptized for the remission of his sins! Praise God! A special thanks goes out to Brother Davis and to everyone one who helped in any way to make this gospel effort a great spiritual feast!
