God's Commission to Joshua

Shepherds Notes

After the death of Moses, the servant of the Lord, it came to pass that the Lord spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel. Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory. No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you (Joshua 1-1-5).

We all have tests and trials to go through in this life. There are times of uncertainty, nervousness, fear or worry. I know we are not supposed to worry, but truth be told we do it anyway. Sometimes these life trials my cause us to forget about the awesome God we serve. Moses died and now Joshua is next in line to take his place in leading the Children of Israel.

Take Notice of what God told Joshua:

"the land which I am giving to them,

"every place I have given you, as I said to Moses"

"as I was with Moses."

"I will be with you"

"I will not leave you"

In the Bible we can read about the great accomplishments of men such as Abraham, Moses, David, Elijah, or any of the prophets or apostles. But we forget about God and put our focus on the men instead of the God behind the man. As we read in the scripture of above, God was there for Moses, and he is also there for us to (Hebrews 13:5).
