The Name of God

Have you ever given any thought to God's name? We call Him such names/titles as God, Almighty, Jehovah, Most Holy, Lord of Hosts, The Most High, Jesus the Christ, King of kings, Lord of lords, Everlasting God, and more. The Bible actually gives us many names and attributions for God which seem to highlight various aspects of His nature, prominence, power, or character. In the Hebrew language, God is known as Elohim, El, El Shaddai, Lord Saboath, Adonai, Yahweh, El Olam, along with others. Last Sunday evening's lesson began with a verse written by the prophet Isaiah wherein God told us His name. In this section of the book, God is revealing through Isaiah's pen the Servant who was to come hundreds of years later, which was Christ. Note what God said here in regard to His Servant and the His name:

"Thus says God the LORD, Who created the heavens and stretched them out, Who spread forth the earth and that which comes from it, Who gives breath to the people on it, And spirit to those who walk on it: ⁶ "I, the LORD, have called You in righteousness, And will hold Your hand; I will keep You and give You as a covenant to the people, As a light to the Gentiles, ⁷To open blind eyes, To bring out prisoners from the prison, Those who sit in darkness from the prison house. ⁸ *I am the LORD, that is My name;* And My glory I will not give to another Nor My praise to carved images."

-Isaiah 42:5-8 (emphasis added by me).

That name which God says belongs to Him is, in Hebrew letters, יהוה. If those Hebrew letters were transliterated into English letters it would look like this, YHWH (if you have an English Bible that translates this word as Yahweh you are familiar with it). If you don't quite recognize those letters, then imagine that Y being pronounced like a J and the W pronounced like a V, which would be JHVH. This is the Hebrew word from which we get our word Jehovah. The process of languages from Hebrew through others into English gave us the differences in variation and the addition of vowel pointings from another Hebrew word all combined to give us Jehovah- a name we know very well in relation to God. This name is what God delivered through the pen of Isaiah as His name.

The word "lord" is written in the Bible in a variety of ways. Sometimes it simply meant someone who was superior. In our lesson last Sunday we read that Abigail, the wife of the scoundrel Nabal, called David 'lord' when he wasn't even king just yet (**1 Sam 25:6**). This is the same word that Peter wrote Sarah used in her relationship with her husband Abraham (**1 Pet 3:6**). Paul wrote to the church in Corinth that in the world there are many "lords" (**1 Cor 8:5**) who exercise authority; he implied in his letter to Timothy that there were many lords in the world when he named God the

“Lord of lords” (*1 Tim 6:15*). That capitalization is the demarcation which separates God from mankind, Lord vs lord. Perhaps you don’t use the word “lord” at all out of deference to God. Perhaps it’s because the United States doesn’t have such types of titles, offices, or ministerial positions as are present in other countries around the world. Regardless, the name commands respect everywhere. With God how much more!

A notable blessing has been extended to the world by the Lord- sharing in His name. Just as when a marriage occurs and the wife takes the name of her husband, you and I have entered into a relationship with God whereby we take His name; hence the word “Christian.” We do not claim that we deserve the name Lord, nor would we ever be so brash as to call ourselves that name; however, we do belong to Him:

“For none of us lives to himself, and no one dies to himself. ⁸For if we live, we live to the Lord; and if we die, we die to the Lord. Therefore, whether we live or die, we are the Lord’s.” -**Romans 14:7-8**

We belong to the Lord, and we are united in a spiritual marriage with Him:

“For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. ³¹“For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.” ³²This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church.” -**Ephesians 5:30-32**

Since that is the case, to borrow a phrase from Peter, “what manner of persons ought we to be” (*2 Peter 3:11*) as we walk in this world, toward Him and eternity? God has given us a taste of His nature (*2 Pet 1:4*) and we are blessed in this world to walk around wearing the name of Him and His Son. As bearers of His name, let us do it no injustice. Live a life where your good works glorify Him and exalt the name He told us belonged to Him (*Psa 7:17*).


