Make Your Call and Election Sure

Everybody wants to feel special from time to time. You might be successful at hiding your disappointment when you're overlooked. You might be adept at suppressing your craving for attention amidst a large group of people (church, family, coworkers, etc.). However, somewhere, perhaps buried inside and ignored occasionally, there is a desire to be treated as if you were special.

God has made you special. Not only has He created you to be unique and blessed you with a special personality and various abilities, but He has made you special to *Him* in and through Jesus (1 Cor 1:4; 2 Cor 5:18). Before God created time, He had a plan for you to access joy, peace, and victory in Jesus:

"And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to *His* purpose. "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to be* conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. "Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, these He also glorified." -Romans 8:28-30

You have been given access to God's special family through the extension of His grace, the shedding of Jesus' blood, and your obedience (if you've believed, repented, confessed, and have been baptized into Christ) to the doctrine which has been delivered to man by the Holy Spirit (*Rom 6:17-18; Jude 3*). You are special because of God. You are special in God. You are special to God. You should be filled with confidence, energy, rejoicing, and indestructible peace in your daily life because you are special and treated as such by God Himself.

Your happiness and "inexpressible joy" (1 Pet 1:8) isn't guaranteed to last though. This startling possibility is not because God's power is inadequate or because His grace has simply run out (Isa 59:1; Rom 5:20-21). If at some point your joy and special status no longer exist it is because you have forfeited it. The Holy Spirit inspired the apostle Paul to write that no created thing can separate us from the love of God which has been made available and is experienced in Christ (Rom 8:37-39). Some have misunderstood and twisted the Scriptures in an attempt to teach that once someone has been saved they cannot lose that salvation. This doctrine has been aptly described as "once saved always saved." Those who adhere to the implications of this doctrine might not describe or designate it as such; nonetheless, that is the conclusion their teaching indicates. The dangerous issue with this doctrine is that this is not taught by the Bible.

False doctrine is rampant when only portions of God's holy word are read and applied. The Holy Spirit did (and still does) teach that nothing can separate us from God's love in Christ. However, the Spirit also taught that some had fallen from grace because they turned their backs on the pathway to justification that God ordained in Christ (*Gal 5:4*). God's word is replete with messages of warning and rebuke for those struggling in their Christian lives and flirting with withdrawal of self from the faith. Jesus (our Lord and Savior whose words will judge us) said that the one who turns around and leaves the plowing isn't fit for the kingdom (*Lk 9:62*). Likewise, the Hebrews penman references an OT text and wrote that if any draw back from the faith

they are no longer in God's pleasure (*Heb 10:38*). The NT is far too saturated with warnings of possible separation and spiritual condemnation for us to ignore them.


The conclusion from Scripture is that you have a personal responsibility to "make your call and election sure" if you want to see God.

"But also for this very reason, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue, to virtue knowledge, 6 to knowledge self-control, to self-control perseverance, to perseverance godliness, ⁷ to godliness brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness love. 8 For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Iesus Christ. 9 For he who lacks these things is shortsighted, even to blindness, and has forgotten that he was cleansed from his old sins. ¹⁰ Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for if you do these things you will never stumble; "for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." -2 Peter 1:5-11

God calls the entire world to salvation through the word (2 Thess 2:14) because He wants everyone to be saved (1 Tim 2:4). Your calling is to obey the gospel and commit yourself to the work of God (Eph 2:10). You not only have a calling, but an election about which you should be concerned. The word for "election" in the text is the word ekloge in Greek which can mean "selection out of and to a given outcome." You are special by God and He wants you to remain in such a relationship with Him and His Son. That decision is up to you. It's up to you to worship. It's up to you to guard your heart from corruption. It's up to you to rid your mind and desire of carnal passions. It's up to you to read your Bible. It's up to you to train your mouth to speak words of grace and not filthiness. It's up to you to remain a part of the Lord's body and not defect to a religion that can never lead you to Heaven. It's up to you to make your call and election sure (Phil 2:12).
