### The Church Moving Forward

I hope you are taking the time to read the article this week. It is in an odd space, as the article is usually on the front page of the church bulletin. Today though, my writing takes a backseat to the advertisement our hardworking secretary made for our gospel meeting. I asked her to construct our bulletin like this for this Sunday because I want you to see it. I want you to remember that we have a gospel meeting coming up. I strongly encourage you to make plans for our gospel meeting.

Our elders care for our souls and for the future of this church. They have received this responsibility from the Holy Spirit (Acts 20:28); but they assumed the responsibility willingly (1 Tim 3:1). These men serve as examples to the flock, and, in this particular activity, their example is furthering our education of God's word in pursuit of growth and maturation. While we should all have this goal (Heb 5:12-14), we might not. You might be content in your Christian life. I heartily suggest you not be content in a cavalier, "good enough" manner. Contentment you're your progress is often highly difficult, if not impossible, to discern from complacency. If we are not looking ahead and forging on in improvement for our soul (Phil 3:14), we are at risk for regression. We should thank the elders for having such intense care and determined passion to cultivate an atmosphere of progress.

You need to be the church "moving forward" and not the church "being dragged forward." There was a text mentioned in the lesson last Sunday night which noted the Amalekites attack of the rear of the Israelites and those who were straggling (*Deut 25:18*). Such are easy pickings for enemies when some lag behind the pack. Don't make yourself an easy target for the adversary; he already is so good at his job (*I Pet 5:8-9*).

Allow me to explain why you should be here for the gospel meeting. I could easily direct you to the book of Hebrews and point to the fact that the Bible says God expects you to be obedient and submissive to those who "rule over you" (*Heb 13:17*). If the elders go to the trouble of discussing, planning, arranging, and paying a speaker to come for the express purpose of improving the state of the church here, you have no solid ground on which to argue that you simply won't attend. God expects you to be obedient. However, that is not the totality of my reasoning from God's word.

You should *want* to attend every night of the gospel meeting because you are "all in" for the enlarging and strengthening of your knowledge in God's word

and, additionally, you are "all in" the growth of the church here. There were various roles and offices created by God for the support, education, and edification (we talked about that word last week) of the church here. The goal is improvement of a whole, by improvement of the pieces:

"...that we should no longer be children, tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting, <sup>16</sup> but, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head-Christ- <sup>16</sup> from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love."

-Ephesians 4:14-16

Come be a part of the body that needs you and wants you (1 Cor 12:25). We only have one gospel meeting in 2024, and it starts next Sunday. Please, I implore you, be here on Sunday morning for class, Sunday morning worship, Sunday evening worship, then Monday night, and Tuesday night, and, of course, Wednesday night. How better could you spend your time? If you have the physical health to be here, remove all of your excuses and hindrances and improve your spiritual health by attending the meeting our elders have crafted for us this year. Give God the glory; give God the time (Ps 18:1-3).
