### **Do You Want to Be Sharp?** By Phil McIntosh

Maybe you've done something in the past where someone has accused you of not being the "sharpest knife in the drawer" or the "sharpest crayon in the box". On the other hand, perhaps your quick wit and impulsiveness to answer some question has gotten you called "sharp as a tack." The idea of sharp there clearly has nothing to do with sharpness as indicative of that which could cut; but rather it is in respect of one who is highly alert, intelligent, or quick witted. We all want to be sharp in that way, do we not? We want to know things and we're happy when we know things; though knowing things comes with its own problems (*1 Cor 8:1*).

I want you to be sharp intellectually, but more importantly, I want you to be sharp spiritually. Using sharp in this manner I'm not just refereeing being intelligent. Every child of God has the expectation and instruction from the Bible to be knowledgeable and capable germane to the word of God (2 Tim 2:15; 1 Pet 3:15). We also need to be able to use that book knowledge in our lives (Heb 5:12-14). Perhaps you've heard of people saying they belong to a particular religion, but they're a "non-practicing" member. May it never be that you are weighed by God to be a nonpracticing Christian.

One easy way to become non-practicing is to practice *isolationist Christianity*. That means to try to be a Christian without being part of the local church. The early church spent a great deal of time with each other (*Acts 2:42-46*). The church is commanded to be together when the weekly opportunity appears (*Heb 10:25*). The church is instructed to reach out and encourage each other to be a part of that community (*Heb 10:24*). Our goal is to experience Christ together, not on a solo basis in our own homes, on our television screen, or on our own schedule (Eph 3:17-19).

The many nodules of the sharpening stone to help hone your Christian life so as to be sharp are gathered frequently at the church building for worship, Bible study, and fellowship. You don't get sharpened at home. You get sharpened when your brothers and sisters assist you, study with you, support you, correct you, and learn about God with you; thus we are all mutually encouraged (*Eph 4:14-16*).

A multiplicity of rough and scouring surfaces in our life will try to wear down our "countenance" (face). Life can erode our sharp Christian exterior if we allow it. One way to arrest that erosion is to continually sharpen that exterior. This is why we need each other. The Proverbs writer said:

"*As* iron sharpens iron, So a man sharpens the countenance of his friend." **-Proverbs 27:17** 

The Hebrew in that text indicates that, just as iron is sharpened by iron, a friend is to be active so to make the countenance (face) of his friend sharp. It's something we're doing to each other. It's something other people do to us.

It's hard, if not impossible, to sharpen a Christian who isn't here. This week we have multiple opportunities, afforded to us by the elders, to make our Christian countenance available to be sharpened by brother Moore and the Word of God. Make plans to be here tonight, Monday night, Tuesday night, and Wednesday night. Each evening you have the invitation to open your Bible and allow someone to sharpen you by God's word. Each evening you have the invitation to be sharpened by those around you who are there for the same purpose. We should learn every time we hear God's word. We get sharper every time we hear God's word. You want to be sharp don't you? Let's be here; let's get sharper together (*1 Pet 2:2*).

"<sup>12</sup> Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus. <sup>13</sup> Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, <sup>14</sup> I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.
